Louisiana's State and Local Capabilities Pre- and Post-Katrina Staffing and Training

Pre-Katrina:

- 6 dedicated mitigation staff
- Limited training through FEMA
- Limited local knowledge of mitigation concepts and funding sources

Post-Katrina:

- 70 mitigation staff and 6 contractors
- Robust training program
 developed specifically for State
 staff as well as local officials








GOHSEP's Repetitive Loss Strategy
