(2) **Spreadsheet Problems and Case Study: 20%** There will be two spreadsheet problems and one case studies. These project would be group work. Each group may contain 3-5 students (maximum 5 students). The project help you to wrap up what you learn from the class. I will post these problems on the **Moodle**. And the group project is due before the class on the due date.

(3) **HOMEWORK:** 15% I will post homework problems every 2-3 weeks. The homework is important because it help you to understand the class material. You could discuss the work with your classmates but must turn it in individually. Hard copies are preferred.
