File 3.1. Description of substituted taxa.

We manually replaced the following 37 species: *Atheris broadleyi* for *A. hispida* – *A. broadleyi* was considered a synonym of *A. hispida* (Menegon et al. 2011); *Boiga andamanensis* for *B. ceylonensis* – *B. andamanensis* was considered a synonym of *B. ceylonensis* (Vogel and Ganesh 2012); *Buhome depressiceps* for *Dityophis vivax* – *Buhome* is regarded as *Lamprophiidae incertae sedis* because of its varied phylogenetic placement between molecular studies (Chapter 1), but was once part of *Geodipsas* (Ziegler et al. 1997), now known as *Compsophis* (Glaw et al. 2007), which *D. vivax* is sister to; *Candoia bibroni* for *C. superciliosa* – *C. superciliosa* is the only other species of *Candoia* represented on the phylogeny; *Corallus caninus* for *C. cropanii* – *C. caninus* was recovered as paraphyletic, but is closely related to *C. cropanii* (Colston et al. 2013); *Conophis vittatus* for *Conopsis nasus* – these genera were paraphyletic with one another, and *C. vittatus* placed in Colubrinae (Chapter 1), but belongs in Dipsadinae (Zaher et al. 2009); *Cyclophiops semicarinatus* for *Ptyas dhumnades* – *Cyclophiops* was synonymized with *Ptyas* (Chapter 1), and *P. dhumnades* is an available terminal on the phylogeny; *Dasypeltis inornata* for *D. gansi*; *Dasypeltis medici* for *D. atra*; *Dendrelaphis calligaster* for *D. formosus*, *D. gastrostictus* for *D. cyanochloris*, and *D. papuensis* for *D. ngansonensis* – *D. calligaster*, *D. gastrostictus*, and *D. papuensis* are closely-related Australo-Papuan species (van Rooijen et al. 2015), and since no other Australo-Papuan *Dendrelaphis* species are represented on the tree, we substituted them with Southeast Asian species that form a clade on the phylogeny; *Dipsadoboa viridis* for *D. brevirostris* – *D. viridis* has been confused with *D. brevirostris* (Rasmussen 1989); *Dipsas andiana* for *D. neivai* – *D. andiana* shows affinities to *D. variegata* (Harvey 2008), which is sister to *D. neivai* on the phylogeny; *Dipsas brevifacies* for *D. articulata*, and *D. sanctijoannis* for *D. pratti* – these species show affinities to one another (Harvey 2008); and *D. temporalis* for *D. peruana* – based on distribution (Harvey and Embert 2008); *Ditaxodon taeniatus* for *Sordellina punctata* – *Sordellina* is in a sister clade to *Philodryas*, which *Ditaxodon* is closely related to (Thomas et al. 2006); *Drymobius chloroticus* for *D. rhombifer* – *D. rhombifer* is the only representative of *Drymobius* on the phylogeny; *Dryocalamus philippinus* for *Lycodon dumerilii* – *Dryocalamus* was synonymized with *Lycodon*, and *L. dumerilii* is in a clade sister to *Dryocalamus* (Chapter 1); *Hemirhagerrhis nototaenia* for *Mimophis mahfalensis* – *M. mahfalensis* is sister to *Hemirhagerrhis* (Chapter 1);

Hoplocephalus stephensii for *Paroplocephalus atriceps* – *P. atriceps* is sister to *Hoplocephalus* (Keogh et al. 2000); *Imantodes phantasma* for *I. chocoensis* – *I. phantasma* is more closely related to *I. chocoensis* than *I. tenuissimus* is (Missassi and Prudente 2015); *Morelia viridis* for *M. carinata* – *M. viridis* was recovered as paraphyletic, but is closely related to *M. carinata* (Reynolds et al. 2014); *Oxyrhopus doliatus* for *O. clathratus* – these species show affinities to one another (Bernardo et al. 2012); *Philothamnus bequaerti* for *P. thomensis* and *P. heterolepidotus* for *P. girardi* – *P. bequaerti* and *P. heterolepidotus* are likely closely-related (Largen and Rasmussen 1993) so we replaced them with *P. thomensis* and *P. girardi* because they are sister species on the phylogeny; *Phimophis guianensis* for *P. guerini* – *P. guerini* is the only representative of *Phimophis* on the phylogeny; *Phisalixella arctifasciatus* for *P. variabilis* – these species are closely-related (Nagy et al. 2010); *Psammophylax multisquamis* for *P. acutus* – *P. acutus* is the only available representative of *Psammophylax* on the phylogeny; *Pseudohaje goldii* for *Aspidelaps scutatus* and *P. nigra* for *Walterinnesia aegyptia* – *Pseudohaje* is closely-related to *Naja* (Bogert 1942), and *Aspidelaps* and *Walterinnesia* formed a clade sister to *Naja* (Chapter 1); *Ptyas korros* for *P. nigromarginata* – *P. korros* was recovered as paraphyletic; *Sibon sanniolus* for *S. annulatus* – these species are closely-related (Rovito et al. 2012); *Sibynomorphus oligozonatus* for *Thamnodynastes pallidus*, and *S. vagrans* for *S. vagus* – *T. pallidus* was paraphyletic and placed within a clade of *Sibynomorphus*, and *S. vagrans* for *S. vagus* show affinities to one another (Cadle 2007); *Telescopus tessellatus* for *T. beetzi* – *T. beetzi* is the only available representative of *Telescopus* on the phylogeny; *Thamnodynastes pallidus* for *T. rutilus* – *T. pallidus* placed was recovered as paraphyletic; and *Tropidodipsas fasciata* for *Sibon noalamina* – *S. noalamina* places as sister to *Tropidodipsas* and *Sibon* (Chapter 1).

The following 23 species were not replaced onto the phylogeny because there were no other species in the genus available on the phylogeny: *Dendroaspis viridis*, *Dendrophidion bivittatus*, *D. nuchale*, *D. paucicarinatum*, *D. rufiterminorum*, *D. vinitor*, *Dipsadoboa aulica*, *Imantodes tenuissimus*, *Ithycyphus goudoti*, *Leptophis mexicanus*, *L. modestus*, *Oxybelis brevirostris*, *O. wilsoni*, *Oxyrhopus fitzingeri* – taxonomy for this species is uncertain (Chapter 1); *Philodryas chamissonis* – taxonomy for this species is uncertain (Zaher et al. 2014); *Plesiodipsas perijanensis*; *Rhamnophis aethiopissa*; *R. batesii*; *Rhinobothryum bovallii*; *Sibon carri*; *Thelotornis mossambicanus*; *Thrasops occidentalis*; and *Tropidodipsas philippii*.

For the arboreal analysis we made the following additional substitutions: *Cyclophiops semicarinatus* for *C. major* – we have no morphological data for *C. major* and it's the only available species of *Cyclophiops* on the phylogeny; and *Dendrophidion paucicarinatum* for *D. percarinatum* and *D. vinitor* for *D. dendrophis* - these species are closely related (Freire et al. 2010).
